



For the 2020-21 school year, Glenview Education Foundation proudly donated over \$107,000 to District 34. Below is a summary of the funded grants:

AAC: A Lifelong Tool – Parent Education Series Invites two successful adult Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) users to speak virtually with District 34 families. The series helps parents understand the power of AAC devices in promoting independence and self-advocacy, followed by family coaching sessions and peer support networks to strengthen home implementation.

District 34 Educator Discovery & Development: Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Provides supplementary funding to complete Phase 1 of the district-wide educator learning initiative started in 2020. "Lead Learners" explore, vet resources, and shape foundational training experiences around equity, diversity, and inclusion to drive future professional development across District 34.

Middle School Maker Modules Funds five hands-on Maker Modules across Attea and Springman Middle Schools to teach engineering skills, design thinking, and inquiry dispositions to 6th–8th graders. Building on earlier K–5 modules, this update enhances core topics—Construction, Circuitry, and Robotics & Coding—while introducing Digital Design & Production and Entrepreneurship to prepare students for high school STEM pathways.
