AAC - A Life Long Tool: A Parent Education Series – submitted by Erin Ross

This grant supports a guest speaking opportunity where two successful adults who communicate using an Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) Device can speak virtually to parents and families of children that use AAC devices to communicate. The goal is for families to understand why AAC is such a powerful tool and how it can help their children self-advocate for themselves to become independent communicators. Families will receive coaching sessions to learn how to implement their children's AAC device at home. Longer term plans include building networks amongst families, so they can share successes and problem solve together.
